

Honeycomb Calcite®

is a recently-discovered natural stone made by Mother Earth and hand crafted by skilled artisans. Since no two pieces of stone are exactly alike, they will vary in color, pattern, and finished size.

Honeycomb Calcite is a beautiful and impressive form of calcite mined exclusively in the state of Utah. The name "Honeycomb Calcite" comes from the remarkable honeycomb appearance of some pieces.

Characteristics that set this stone apart from other forms of calcite are its color, patterns, translucency, transparency, its ability to accept a high polish, and the fact that it does not fade as readily in sunlight as other forms of calcite.

The color ranges from a pale sunshine-yellow to a deep golden amber, depending upon the thickness of the stone. The coloring of the stone is attributed to sulphur deposits at the time of formation.

The patterns range from a tight "honey sugar" look of small hexagonal cells grouped close together, to large cell areas that give the appearance of petrified honey where cells are at their maximum growth and minimum cell walls appear.

Honeycomb calcite is heavy, with a density greater than concrete or granite. The mining process is environmentally-friendly.

The stone is transparent and translucent, offering a soothing glow when illuminated by candles, electric lights, or sunlight. Honeycomb calcite is ideal for cutting, carving, polishing, or any decorative stone application.

Enjoy the remarkable glow everywhere: in the living room, bedroom, kitchen, bathroom, near a window, in the fireplace, or even outdoors on the patio, by the pool, or in your RV. The possibilities are endless.
